A Premium, High-Energy Feed for all Performance Horses

- Dunstan Sporthorse is a premium high-energy complete feed. It
 includes extruded cereals for improved digestibility, and therefore it is
 less likely to cause digestive upsets as a result of excessive fermentation
 in the caecum or hind-gut.
- Includes Oats, a highly digestible grain for horses, further enhancing the energy density and highly digestible nature of Dunstan Sporthorse.
- The addition of Vegetable Oil enhances skin and coat condition and contributes an alternative concentrate source of calories to Dunstan Sporthorse.
- Dunstan Sporthorse contains a comprehensive formula of Minerals.
- Minerals are provided as Glycinate Organic Trace Minerals resulting in improved bio-availability. This ensures maximum feed and nutrient utilisation, also aiding development of the natural immune system.
- Organic Selenium as Selenium Yeast is included, to provide a highly available and safe form of Selenium.
- Chromium Yeast is an addition to Dunstan Sporthorse that enhances performance through improved energy utilisation and lactic acid reduction.
- Dunstan Sporthorse includes highly bio-available Natural Vitamin E.



FEEDING RECOMMENDATIONS

Amounts per horse per day when offerred as the full feed	
Light Work	2kg – 3kg
Moderate Work	3kg - 4kg
Hard Work	4kg – 6kg

The above feeding rates for **Dunstan Sporthorse** are guidelines only and are based on a 500kg horse. Feed amounts will vary depending on pasture availability, body condition and an individual metabolic rate.

FEEDING NOTES

- Divide the daily feed into as many feeds as possible, at least two, but feed no more than 2kg of Dunstan Sporthorse per feed.
- If pasture is limited, increased levels of fibre must be added to the diet. The minimum requirement of 1.0% of the horses's body weight must be fed as fibre each day, (on a dry matter basis). Supplementary fibre can be provided in the form of hay, chaff and Dunstan Betabeet/Dunstan Sugarbeet.
- Always introduce a new feed gradually over a period of 7 - 10 days.
- Always ensure the horse has access to clean drinking water.
- High Copper levels in **Dunstan Sporthorse** make it unsuitable for feeding to sheep.
