FEEDING RECOMMENDATIONS

Feeding rates below are based on a 500kg bodyweight. Adjust intakes as required depending on bodyweight.

- Last Trimester of a mares pregnancy 500grams per day
- Spelling horse 300grams per day
- Light work 400grams per day
- Moderate..... 500grams per day

GENERAL NOTES

Always ensure the Horse has access to clean drinking water. High Copper levels in **Dunstan TriMAREster** make it unsuitable for feeding to sheep.
